- □ Ranks:
  - Lecturer/Senior Lecturer/Associate Prof./Prof.
  - Professor level 1-4
  - Lecturer/Senior Lecturer/Reader/Professor
  - Instructor/Assistant Prof/Associate Prof/Professor
- □ Requirements:
  - Teaching, research, administration, leadership, social responsiveness
